
AED EMERGENCY ACTION PLAN FOR SUDDEN CARDIAC ARREST

In the event of a medical emergency, 911 should be called and Automated External Defibrillator (AED) should be part of emergency response equipment brought to the scene.

The AEDs have voice prompts and provide step-by-step instructions for proper operation. Be sure to follow instructions on specific AED unit to ensure maximum effectiveness and safety of victim, rescuer and bystanders.
